Job Summary:

The Lacrosse Coach, under the Athletics Director's supervision, is responsible for developing the girls' lacrosse program. In this role, the primary responsibility will be coaching the JV team which includes the development of players and assistant coaches, as well as working with the Athletics Director to build the culture of lacrosse on campus.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Teaches appropriate fundamentals, techniques, and skills
- Is responsible for the health and safety of the athletes during practices and games while partnering with the school's athletic trainer
- Articulates a well-defined and understandable coaching philosophy to athletes and parents
- Applies developmental and age-appropriate methods to coaching student-athletes
- Emphasizes sportsmanship and leadership among athletes
- Clearly communicates with players, parents, administrators, and staff, including submitting a post-game recap form for official school records and communication
- Positively motivates athletes and promotes teamwork
- Attends all meetings and training as required by the Athletics Director
- Is familiar with and complies with all policies as put forth in Shorecrest documents
- Distributes, collects and is responsible for team uniforms
- Manages and maintains team equipment
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Athletics Director

- Demonstrated competence and experience in coaching lacrosse required.
- Deep knowledge of the intricacies of the game of lacrosse.
- Efficient, well organized, and able to handle a variety of duties simultaneously.
