In this role, the primary responsibility will be coaching the varsity team while providing direction to the Middle School team during our winter sports season.

- Attends all meetings and training as required by the Athletics Director

- Is familiar with and complies with all policies as put forth in Shorecrest documents
- Distributes, collects and is responsible for team uniforms
- Manages and maintains team equipment
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Athletics Director
