



**Position Title:** **Band Director (Grades 4-12)**  
**Reports To:** Middle & Upper School Heads  
**Position Purpose:** To grow and direct a Beginning Band Program (4<sup>th</sup> grade, after-school), Intermediate Band Program (Middle School), and Concert Band Program (Upper School).

### **Essential Functions**

- Instruct and manage an instrumental music program for students in Lower School (grade 4), Middle School (grades 5-8) and Upper School (grades 9-12).
- A willingness to teach 1-2 courses in the Upper School as needed.
- Coordinate concert performances in the Fall and Spring.
- Collaborate with other faculty and staff as part of a community that emphasizes mutual support and shared programmatic creation and implementation.
- Performs other duties as assigned by their Supervisor.

### **Qualifications**

- A Bachelor's degree or post graduate work.
- A minimum of five years experience performing, directing or conducting music.
- A thorough knowledge of musical instruments.
- Proficiency with technology including iPad, learning management systems, and basic G Suite for Education (Google) tools
- Ability to use basic office equipment.
- A commitment to inclusion and issues of social justice and equity.
- Candidates should possess excellent verbal and written communication skills and a willingness to use said skills for the purpose of promoting and growing the program.

### **Physical Requirements and Work Environment**

- Be able to occasionally lift musical instruments and equipment
- Work primarily in a traditional climate controlled music room environment
- Work intermittently in outside weather conditions, including heat and cold
- Be able to work in a very busy and highly involved environment
